Maldives: Bans meat imports from Tamil Nadu over anthrax fears

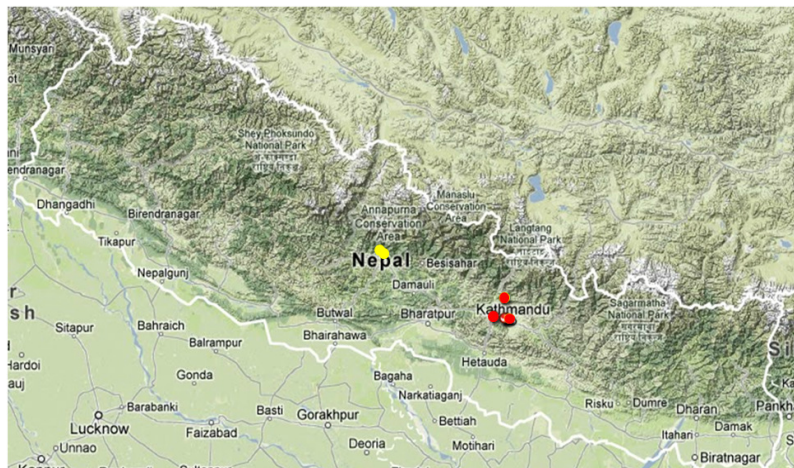

Pakistan: Crimean-Congo haemorrhagic septicemia

Three suspected CCHF cases were reported from Balochistan in 2013. Approximately all the cases have contact history with animal trading/handling, tick bite, contact with patient, tannery worker, butcher/animals slaughtering, a traditional practice of wearing fresh animal skin to treatment ailment. These animals and their skins have continuous movement intra Pakistan and between neighboring countries (Afghanistan and Iran).

Vietnam: At least three bird flu outbreaks for January 2013

People and the authorities in Van Ninh Province has destroyed nearly 15,000 infected poultry and applied quarantine measures to prevent spread of the diseases.

In Haiphong (city), animal health centre of the An Lao district has discovered that a flock of more than 10,000 ducks of Mrs. Ngo Thi Thoan family (Tan Thang community, Chien Thang sub-district, An Lao district) has symptoms of avian influenza.

Prior to that, on 5 January, in Yen Thanh district, Nghe An province, nearly 1,300 poultry infected with H5N1 have been destroyed. Yellow dots show outbreak locations.
