### **Nepal: New outbreak of HPAI in Kathmandu**

At least three bird flu cases were detected in Kathmandu. The first outbreak was confirmed at a private poultry farm of Kishor Tandukar in Jitpurphedi on the outskirts of Kathmandu on Friday with 2,390 birds from the Jitpurphedi-based farm were culled and 100 kg chicken feed destroyed on Friday and Saturday.
