China: JE in Taiwan

A 17-year-old male was diagnosed with Japanese encephalitis (JE) earlier this month, making it the nation's second confirmed case of the viral disease this year, the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) said yesterday. The teen exhibited symptoms, including fever, headaches and vomiting on May 31, and later experienced reduced consciousness and a stiff neck, the agency said, adding that his illness was confirmed to be Japanese encephalitis after he was hospitalized on June 1. Indonesia: Toddler died from H5N1 in Bekasi, West Java

Malaysia: 7 died from leptospirosis

Seven deaths out of 122 cases of rat urine infection (leptospirosis) were recorded in Kelantan this year until June 10, showing an increase over the figures in 2011 and 2012. Kelantan Health director Datuk Ahmad Razin Ahmad Maher said the number of deaths was the highest since the compulsory reporting of cases was gazetted and issued in December 2010. [read more](#)

A woman in Vinh Long province died of the flu at the provincial hospital on June 16. In the afternoon of June 17, the HCM City Pasteur Institute transferred the test results to the authorities of Vinh Long province, which identified that the patient was infected with H1N1 influenza virus.
