Australia: Hendra virus in New South Wales

A horse has died from the Hendra virus on a property on the NSW mid north coast, in the state's first case of the infection for almost two years. The property west of Macksville has been placed in quarantine following the mare's sudden death on Wednesday. [read more](#)

China: FMD type A in Yunnan

The Ministry of Agriculture reported an outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease caused by type A in Heping village, Xianggelila, Diqing, Yunnan Province which led to culling of 1213 cattle and 554 pigs. [read more](#)

China: Update on H7N9 in human

India: PRRS in Mizoram
