### **Cambodia: New confirmed H5N1 human case**

The 17<sup>th</sup> case was a 6-years-old boy from Prey Tathuk Village, Prek Sleng commune, Kandal Stung district in Kandal province was confirmed positive for human H5N1 avian influenza on 17th August 2013 by Institut Pasteur du Cambodge. [read more](#)

### **China: 109 confirmed rabies cases in Taiwan**

According to the Animal Technology Institute Taiwan, Council of Agriculture, Taiwan, there were two new cases of rabies in ferret-badgers, bringing the number of reported rabies infections to 107 since mid-July, when the first rabies case in Taiwan for more than 50 years. The four new confirmed cases were reported from Guoshing, Shueili and Yuchih Townships of Nantou and Gukeng Township of Yunlin. [read more](#)

### **China: Foot and mouth disease serotype A in Tibet**

According to China Animal Disease Control Centre, Veterinary Bureau, Beijing there were two new outbreaks of FMD reported from Qiaze and Naqu Village of Naqu, Tibet. To prevent the spread, a total of 388 cattle were culled. [read more](#)

### **Malaysia: Leptospirosis killed 28 in 2013**

Another 150 cases of leptospirosis have been reported within a two-week period nationwide since Aug 10. Health Minister Datuk Seri Dr S. Subramaniam said the latest statistic has brought the total number of rat urine disease cases to 2,925 so far this year. A total of 28 deaths were reportedly caused by the disease as of Aug 24. ### **Nepal: More bird flu in Kavre**

Bird flu has been confirmed in Kavre villages. According to District Livestock Office, the H5N1 virus has spread to the villages from Kavre's Nasikasthan, Sanga, Ugratara Jangal, Mahendrajyoti, Dhulikhel, and Panauti. Samples from the poultry farms belonging to Sudarshan Ghimire at Patlekhel-4 and Niranjan Dahal at Ugrachandi Nala VDC-6 had tested positive for bird flu on Friday, the livestock office informed. ### **Nepal: More bird flu in Kathmandu**

A few new places, apart from the bird flu emergency zone inside Kathmandu district, have been seeing new cases of bird flu outbreaks, preventing the authorities from carrying out blanket slaughtering in the emergency areas. On Thursday, bird flu was confirmed at two poultry farms of Bhadrabas and Sankhu, while an outbreak was reported in some farms at Sundarijal, Nayapati and Gokarna, among others. [read more](#)
