### **China: 9 new rabies cases confirmed in Taiwan**

As of this week, a total of 225 rabies outbreaks involving 226 ferret-badgers, one Asian house shrew and a puppy bitten by a ferret-badger have tested positive for rabies infection, were reported by the Central Epidemic Command Center reported on 12 November 2013, adding that the number of cities and counties that have confirmed cases of rabid animals remained unchanged at nine.
