### **Cambodia: Confirmed 3 outbreaks of H5N1 in poultry**

Three outbreaks of H5N1 were reported to OIE by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries on 12 and 26 February 2014. These outbreaks include:

- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Svay Prey, Sandaek, Batheay, Kampong Cham with 4,466 poultry died and 784 destroyed. [read more](#)
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Peam Lvea, Trapang Chau, Aoral, Kampong Speu with 210 poultry died and 240 destroyed.
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Tuol Sangkae, Kampong Kong, Koh Thom, Kandal with 200 poultry died and 50 destroyed. [read more](#)

### **China: 13 new confirmed H7N9 cases in Human**

Most of the cases had history of either in-contact with poultry or live bird/farmer markets.

- 71-year-old man from Nanhai, Foshen. His condition is critical. [read more](#)

### **China: Confirmed H7N9 in poultry in Hunan**

Two chicken specimens collected from live bird markets in Hunan Province were tested positive for H7N9.

- One of 45 chicken specimens collected from Chengbei live bird market in Shuangfeng, Loudi City was tested positive for H7N9.
- One of 13 chicken specimens collected from Gelin new city live bird market in Changsha was tested positive for H7N9. [read more](#)

### **China: 6 new rabies cases confirmed in Taiwan**

As of this week, a total of 329 rabies outbreaks involving 332 ferret-badgers, one Asian house shrew and a puppy bitten by a ferret-badger have tested positive for rabies infection, were reported by the Central Epidemic Command Centre reported on 26 February 2014, adding that the number of cities and counties that have confirmed cases of rabid animals remained unchanged at nine. ### **Nepal: Confirmed an outbreak of H5N1**

An outbreak of H5N1 was reported to OIE by the Department of Livestock Services on 26 February 2014 in a commercial layer farm in Itahari Municipality 7, Itahari, Sunsari, Koshi with a total of 570 poultry died and 1,430 destroyed. [read more](#)

### **Philippines: Rabies cases up in Surigao City, Mindanao**

The City Health Office (CHO) here said cases of rabies virus in the city have increased from January to February, this year. City Health Officer Dr. Emmanuel A. Plandano, during the press conference held recently, said three human deaths caused by rabies were recorded by the communicable disease coordinator in the first two months of this year. Dr. Plandano said the victims were from different barangays of the city, "one 50-year old, male from Purok 10, Barangay Mabini died on January 22; one 8 year-old boy from Purok 5, Barangay Canlanipa died on February 11 and one 54-year old, female from Purok 1, Barangay Serna died last February 26." ### **Viet Nam: Confirmed 3 outbreaks of H5N1 in poultry**

Three outbreaks of H5N1 were reported to OIE by the Department of Animal Health on 25 February 2014 with a total of 2,403 poultry died and 550 destroyed. These outbreaks include:

- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Phu Tho with 1113 poultry died.
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Tieu Can, Tieu Can, Tra Vinh with 500 poultry died and 550 destroyed.
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Binh Dinh with 790 poultry died. [read more](#)

### **Viet Nam: Confirmed 4 outbreaks of H5N1 in poultry**

Four outbreaks of H5N1 were reported to OIE by the Department of Animal Health on 01 March 2014 with a total of 3,742 poultry died and 7,563 destroyed. These outbreaks include:

- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Cam Che, Cam Che, Thanh Ha, Hai Duong with 250 poultry died and 350 destroyed.
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Dak Po, Gia Lai with 2,004 poultry died and 2,496 destroyed.
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Nga Nam, Soc Trang with 134 poultry died and 371 destroyed.
- one outbreak in backyard poultry in Dai Tu, Dai Dong, Van Lam, Hung Yen with 1,354 poultry died and 4,346 destroyed. [read more](#)
