Republic of Korea: Third FMD outbreak in Gyeongsang

After foot-and-mouth disease (FMD) was confirmed yesterday at a pig farm in Hapcheon County, South Gyeongsang, local authorities took follow-up measures to prevent the disease from spreading. The pig farm reported symptoms suspected to be those of FMD Wednesday. The Animal and Plant Quarantine Agency confirmed yesterday that the animals had contracted the disease. The provincial government also said yesterday that they have already culled 121 pigs that showed FMD symptoms at the farm. [read more](#)

Malaysia: Suspected leptospirosis in a human

A suspected leptospirosis patient from Kapit Division, who fell into a coma, was transferred to Sibul Hospital yesterday. The 40-year-old farmer had fallen sick at his longhouse on the outskirts of Kapit town and was taken to Kapit Hospital. He is said to have vomited blood and was weak. Kapit Hospital had the man transferred to Sibul by helicopter, where he was admitted to the Intensive Care Unit (ICU). [read more](#)

Malaysia: JE cases in Penang

The three cases of Japanese Encephalitis in Penang come from different areas in the state, Penang state executive councillor for health Dr Afif Bahardin said today, suggesting that the infections did not come from a common source. Two cases come from George Town and Bagan Jermal in north Seberang Perai. In the third case infection is believed to have happened in Tasek Gelugor. [read more](#)

Viet Nam: Confirmed 2 outbreaks of HPAI H5N6

Two outbreaks of HPAI H5N6 were reported by the Department of Animal Health to OIE on 12 August 2014. These outbreaks were in:

- Keo Quang Village, Chi Lang, Trang Dinh, Lang Son with 15 poultry died and 65 destroyed.
- Tan Son Village, Ky Tho, Ky Anh, Ha Tinh with led to destroyed 1900 poultry.
