Visa on Arrival

Citizens from 64 countries are eligible for applying for a Visa on Arrival (VOA).

This visa can be obtained directly when you arrive at certain airports and seaports in Indonesia, regardless of the purpose of your visit (Business, Tourist, Social-Cultural).

Visa on Arrival is neither a work visa nor a visit visa. Therefore, it cannot be extended or converted into another immigration permit. The maximum stay permitted is thirty (30) days and can be extended (one time) for a maximum thirty (30) days

General Requirements for a Visa on Arrival:

- a. The applicant's passport must be valid for at least 6 (six) months from the date of entry
- b. Round-trip airplane ticket
- c. Fees:
 - Up to 7 (seven) days: US\$ 15
 - Up to 30 (thirty) days: US\$ 35

4. Hotel Information

A block of room booking at the Santika Premiere Dyandra Hotel & Convention has been made at a special rate of Rp. 580,000/night, valid only for bookings made within 10 May 2015. **Participants are invited to take care of their own reservations and related settlement of payment with the hotel.** Room key **MUST BE RETURNED** to the front desk when checking out. **Any NON-RETURNED key will be charged Rp. 50,000 to your account.**



5. Airport Transport Information

Please be informed that there is **no shuttle service provided by the Organizers**. The easiest mode of transport is **TAXI or Car Rental** (see below).

1. *Blue Bird Taxi*

Located at the Passenger Terminal, taxis are available 24 hours, 7 days a week. You may need to show the address of the Grand Aston Hotel in Medan to the taxi driver. The one-way fare from Kualanamu Airport in Medan to the hotel is estimated to be approximately **IDR¹ 100,000 – 200,000** (USD 8 - 15).

The company of *Blue Bird Taxi* is recommended by the United Nations Department of Safety and Security (UNDSS)

2. *Car Rental*

Located at the Passenger Terminal, available from 09.00 – 19.00, 7 days a week. You may need to show the address of the Grand Aston Hotel in Medan to the car rental booth and driver. The car rental fare is vary from IDR220,000 – 300,000 (USD17 – 23) per unit which can accommodate up to 5 passengers.

The car rental company recommended to be used is Golden Bird, ASSA, and TRAC.

3. *Airport Train*

Airport train is available from Kualanamu Airport to Medan Station which is located close to the venue approx. 10 min walking distance. The cost is Rp. 100,000 for one-way trip.

6. Currency and foreign exchange services

The currency in Indonesia is the Indonesian Rupiah (IDR). The current exchange rate is approximately: 1 USD equal to IDR 12,831.0 (As of 25 March 2015). All major credit cards are readily accepted in Indonesia. Money exchange facilities are available at the arrival Airport in Medan and in tourist areas.

7. Climate

Indonesia has a tropical climate with the only exception being high mountain areas. The climate in Medan has a tropical rainforest climate with no dry season. The month of May is characterized by essentially constant daily high temperatures, with daily highs around 33°C throughout the month, exceeding 34°C or dropping below 31°C only one day in ten. Daily low temperatures are around 24°C, falling below 23°C or exceeding 26°C only one day in ten. Packing for dry conditions is advisable for this meeting.

8. Electricity

In Indonesia, the standard electricity voltage is 220 Volt (50 Hz). There are different plugs and sockets in use, however the most common are socket C and F (*Europlug* and *Shuko* – see picture below).

Travellers with shavers, tape recorders, laptops and other appliances having different voltage settings and/or plugs should carry a voltage adapter (e.g. 220 Volt to 110 Volt) and/or a plug-adaptor kit.
