"Raising awareness, and sharing of data and experience on the implementation of the GBEP indicators"

Rome, 1 December 2016

Background note

During the AG2 meeting in Rome in November 2015, it was agreed that experiences from implementation of the indicators in various countries should be collected. A template was therefore devised to facilitate the collection of lessons learnt. This was circulated by the GBEP secretariat and a total of nine templates were completed from Argentina, Colombia, Egypt, Germany, Ghana, Indonesia, Jamaica, Japan and the Netherlands. These templates (posted on the [GBEP website](#)), will be used to inform the work of the Task Force for Sustainability on the development of the Implementation Guide.

The table below shows where the GBEP indicators have been piloted so far. A total of ten countries have implemented the indicators, seven at the national level (Argentina, Colombia, Germany, Ghana, Indonesia, Jamaica and the Netherlands) and three at the local level (Brazil, Egypt and Japan). Five countries are currently in the process of implementing the indicators (Paraguay, USA, Ukraine, Uruguay and Vietnam) and Germany is currently implementing the indicators for a second time. Six countries also plan to implement them in the near future (China, Ethiopia, India, Italy, Kenya and Sudan).
