Dear Colleagues,

Following multiple enquiries from our members regarding a petition which is circulating among UN staff related to the investments branch of the UN Joint Staff Pension Fund ([UNJSPF](#)),

FICSA would like to clarify that it is not a signatory to the petition in question.

FICSA participated in the most recent meeting of the [Board of the UNJSPF](#) as an observer as well as in all preparatory and related meetings of the participants representatives' group. Those participants representatives, elected by staff, were joined at the Board meeting by representatives of the Organizations and Member States. At no time did any FICSA member raise concerns about the investment branch of the Pension Fund, including during the meeting of the Board of the UNJSPF when these issues were presented for discussion.

Following concerns raised by one of the Staff Federations, the Representative of the Secretary General / Chief, Office of Investment Management (OIM) invited FICSA as well as the other two Staff Federations to a meeting to address those concerns. FICSA was satisfied with the explanations provided during that meeting. Subsequently, the Chief, OIM, has sent [a message to all UN staff](#) explaining the current situation regarding investments on behalf of the UNJSPF.
